#### Projects KCCC have organised or supported:

- Attractive, locally made mosaic table tops on all public dining tables in Katoomba Street.
- New banner poles and banners that are clean, attractive and easily accessed with more banners planned as funds become available.
- Poster poles to advertise 'What's on' in Katoomba to prevent unsightly plastering of notices on public furniture and light poles.
- The annual 'Katoomba Wines of the West Festival' which brings tourists to the area and also offers locals a weekend of wine and food tasting from the area and entertainment.
- Since 2000, started and supported the 'Katoomba Eatstreet & Town Map'.
- Helped produce and publicise the 'Katoomba Heritage & Art Walk Map'.
- Recent purchase of a community controlled 'clean up' trailer, purchased through fund raising and donations – most weekends, 2 volunteers are on the streets, removing graffiti from public places. Two more trailers have been commissioned by lower mountains groups using our model.
- Members of the Chamber have worked hard to obtain 'Cittaslow Status' (Slow Food) for the mountains. An Italian initiative which is now a world wide movement, encouraging locals and visitors to 'slow down' and appreciate locally produced food and produce.
- KCCC support, volunteer, and sponsor the 'Winter Magic Festival' as it is our unique premier event of the year. It is also our largest Blue Mountains festival, and hosts around 30,000 to 40,000 people .
- Working bees which include: participation in clean up Australia Day, painting of Studleigh Car park Fence, maintenance and replanting of pots in Katoomba Street.
- Initiated and obtained funding from State Government and organised the installation, maintenance and supervision of CCTV cameras in Katoomba Street. Improving police crime statistics.
- Christmas late night shopping - a growing event.
- Bendigo Bank : Opened in December 2009 at 117 Katoomba Street, after 2 years hard work by a steering committee, our own **Katoomba & Upper Blue Mountains Bendigo Community Bank® Branch** which is a local employer and has begun to return serious profits back into our community. The Branch has applications forms inviting potential projects and groups to apply for sponsorships. The Branch mobile canopy is also available for use, free, to approved events (application forms available at the Branch).Our up coming projects:
- Working with Council for an attractive, welcoming 'Welcome to Katoomba' entry way.
- Christmas and Yulefest decorations.
- Successfully lobbied State and Federal Government for a commuter car park opposite Gearins Hotel. Soon to be opened, with 3 disabled spaces available on the Old Goods Yard site
